I now have doubts I didn't otherwise have at some level.  4. I need to embrace the mystery of God.  Some suggestions for engaging God in grief:  - Make a list of losses  - Do a journal entry of "What might have been?" if		
<ul> <li>Think, write and talk about the truth that things won't ever be what they were before this. We/things can never return to life the way it was before.</li> <li>Set timer for time period of grief either daily like 10 min or weekly</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>Write out a lament in the manner of Psalms of how you long to "get back to normal" or "way it should be."</li> </ul>		
How we are made more effective through engaging grief:		
1. Grieving helps us realize there is no true and lasting comfort apart from  Matthew 5:4 Isaiah 53:3 Psalm 56:8		
2. Grieving helps us become more - in the lives of others
