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## Tuition Information

**Grades 1-6 - \$175 per student, per semester (\$350/year)**

**Grades 7-8 - \$200 per student, per semester (\$400/year)**

**\*All tuition payments are non-refundable.\***

Winter/spring tuition will be due not later than Friday, December 8, 2023, to ensure your spot for the following semester.

Tuition will include all supply fees for the year although teachers may occasionally ask if students can bring in specific materials to complete a project. Students will also need to provide basic supplies, such as pencils, crayons, gluesticks, etc.



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## Attendance Policy

Enrolling in HBA means committing to all three classes each Friday morning. It is important that families be on time and fulfill this commitment. The teachers have also made a commitment and have spent time preparing for each student who is registered.

If a student misses more than three “unexcused” classes without proper notice, she/he will be asked to leave the HBA program. Teachers are not responsible for helping students make up missed work. Any unfinished projects will be sent home for students to complete on their own.

**Planned Absences:** If a parent knows in advance that a class day will be missed, they are welcome to work with the teacher to cover any missed materials.





## Parent Responsibilities

Although HBA hires teachers for our primary classes, we are still cooperative in nature, and parents are vital to the program's success. Each parent is required to participate in the co-op on a regular basis throughout the year. (Number of times will be based on the number of families participating.)

### **Please consider the parent requirements before applying for enrollment:**

- Sign up for dates to assist in classes or as transition facilitator (this job is ideal for those with younger children)
- Commit to serving on your scheduled dates
- Participate in planning or assisting at least one extra-curricular opportunity, ie, field trip, group party, park day, etc.
- Maintain Heritage Christian Church's standards for ministry workers, including a background check.
